## ECONOMY

- Push for a 'Green New Deal' to revitalize business, creating a new alliance between environmentalists, industry, agriculture and unions to put the interests of the real economy ahead of those of footloose finance.
- Massive investment in renewable energy and wider environmental transformation in the UK, leading to the creation of thousands of 'green collar' jobs.
- Ensure that the bias in the collection of taxes is shifted from taxes on income to eco-taxes. This means different - not more - taxation.
- Replacing the GDP as a measure of economic progress (as it is an indicator of merely total economic activity and not people's well-being) with green, sustainable indicators of the economy such as the ISEW.
- Introduce legislation, in consultation with the unions, to encourage tele-working and home working.
