What we stand for

The founding principles of the Green Party are based on commitments to peace building, local democracy, environmental protection, and social justice. We are the only Party that makes the vital links between our economy, the quality of our democracy, and our use of limited resources. We recognise the urgent need to reduce our dependence on fossil fuels and to plan transport and infrastructure in a way that protects the climate, creates sustainable jobs and gives us warm, energy efficient homes.

How the Party works

The Green Party is a democratic party, largely run by its members on a voluntary basis. Local groups, organised on a constituency basis, play an important role alongside Party staff in organising meetings and events, canvassing and fundraising. Local groups select candidates to run in local, regional and general elections. The GPNI Executive Committee meets monthly to make decisions on Party organisation and to develop policy in Northern Ireland. GPNI members also contribute to the National Executive Committee in Dublin. One of founding principles of the Green Party is that all political, social and economic decisions should be taken at the lowest effective level. Because of this, no major decision is taken within the Party without the support of two thirds of the membership at the AGM or an Emergency General Meeting.
